



How to Revise for Maths

Homework – Due EVERY Monday

- 1) **MathsWatch** – 30 minutes additional questions to fill gaps in knowledge, review learning or prepare directly for upcoming mock exams.
- 2) **Past Paper Friday** – finish over the weekend and mark in class on Monday
- 3) **Half Papers** – Some classes will be set additional half-past-papers to complete

Pearson Revise Online

Spending some time every week using your mock feedback sheets to work on your less confident topics by using the fantastic tool on Pearson Revise will really boost your grade. See the email from the start of the year with the link.

Chosen students will benefit from guided revision, focused on topics carefully identified from the last round of mock exams, with the view to boost their grade.




New Years Resolution – Starting January 2025

Past - Exam Papers!

Past exam papers are the real key to success. Students who regularly practise these, ensuring they fill any gaps in their knowledge they may find (via the mark scheme, Mathswatch, YouTube or a maths teacher) not only dramatically improve their mathematical ability but improve their confidence in sitting exams. These students are not stressed or worried about maths during exam season – **they feel prepared because they are.**
