2. Also allow you to amend your answers in purple pen. This will help you learn from your mistakes and rewrite your answer in better detail.

Top Tip

Be mindful of the time you are taking on each question, remember you have 1 hour 45 minutes to complete the whole paper! Focus on saving enough time to complete the D style questions



Remember to focus practicing our FOUR exam question types

a	Outline	Brief statement
b & c	Explain	Develop - show understanding
d	Evaluate	Find strengths or weaknesses within arguments to make a final judgement on the strongest argument

Remember that we use the acronym DREARES to answer all D style questions
