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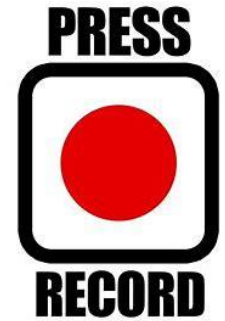

CONFIDENCE

Studies have shown that confidence in yourself/ your outcome or your knowledge can have up to a 12% increase on your test score



PARENTAL SUPPORT

- Ensure they are on time, fed and watered
- Familiarise yourself with their exam timetable
- Actually talk about how they and you feel, it's not just the child who is under pressure
- There's nothing wrong with a kick-a-bout!
- You get out what you put in



PARENTAL SUPPORT

- Plan- put times together for work, family, fun, exercise and whatever else is important to your family
- Dinner time conversation
- Don't bribe but reward
 - Bribe = *"IF I let you watch TV now, you must do your homework straight afterwards"*
 - Reward = *"WHEN you have completed your homework, you will have earned your screen time."*
- Promote parity between subjects
- Do you know what they are REALLY doing?





PARENTAL SUPPORT

School work and life is their responsibility

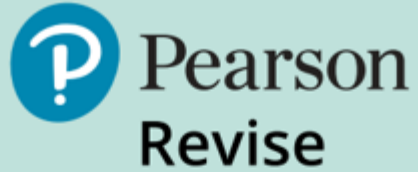
